The webinar will also cover key legal options, including the Caregiver's Authorization Affidavit and Guardianship, so families understand what these tools are, how they work, and when they may be appropriate. In addition, parents will receive information about resources available to support families in their communities. This webinar offers practical information, an opportunity to ask questions, and guidance on next steps families may wish to consider.
